We are excited to let you know about our upcoming 4th GAIC-MUN (Gyeonggi Academy International Conference - Model United Nations) event, which will be held for three days from August 11 to August 13, 2017.

Model United Nations is a simulative United Nations conference where students participate as chairs, delegates and journalists, and discuss international issues including national security, development, environment and human rights. Through compromise and negotiation, the participants seek solutions and attend meetings, interview, write articles, take photographs and publish newspapers.

Students directly and independently run the GAIC-MUN by organizing the secretariat, planning and operating the conference. In addition to domestic middle and high school participants, students from foreign countries are invited to the event in August. They will spend three days and two nights on the GAFL campus and debate the designated agenda for each committee. In particular, 2017 GAIC-MUN will be running on a larger scale with a total of nine committees, including three for high school and six for middle school students. This year, we expect over 300 participants as chairs, delegates and journalists.

The slogan for 2017 GAIC-MUN is 'Action for Humanity'. We have chosen this slogan in order to reflect the basic purpose of the establishment of the United Nations and to have time to consider the conflicts occurring in the world at the moment through a common purpose called 'humanity'. The agendas correspond to the United Nations' sustainable development goals, such as terrorism, tax avoidance, poverty refugees, gender discrimination, preservation of cultural heritage and sustainable energy.

We would like to welcome your students to GAIC-MUN where they will be able to grow as global citizens as they cultivate their negotiation and presentation skills, and develop a broader understanding of leading a fair and just society.
