We are excited to let you know about our upcoming 5th GAIC-MUN (Gyeonggi Academy International Conference-Model United Nations), which will be held from July 9<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> in Gyeonggi Academy of Foreign Languages (GAFL).

Model United Nations (MUN) is an educational activity simulating a United Nations conference. Participants in MUN take their role as a chair, delegate or journalist, and debate on diverse international issues (security, development, environment and human rights). Participants are expected to suggest solutions for issues by taking part in debates requiring overall negotiation skills and teamwork. In addition, student journalists will participate in the conference and publish newspaper by writing articles, interviewing participants and taking pictures during the event.

GAIC-MUN is initiatively hosted by student participants. The Secretariat plays their roles in the main MUN tasks. In addition, GAIC-MUN not only invites junior high and high school students from Korea but also from abroad, so that international students with diverse background can participate in the session. The international students will be staying at GAFL for three days as well and are expected to have in-depth discussions about a number of agendas set by the committees. This year will be a special year for the participants, having eight assigned committees in total (two from high school committees and six from middle school committees). This events has attracted over 300 participants already, with more expected to join.

GAIC-MUN has its purpose in contemplating diverse global conflicts occurring in the world and reestablishing the goal of the United Nations ourselves by finding humanity, which is the common ultimate goal of all. Agendas are set according to significant issues such as terrorism, regulations on AI militarization, gender inequality and qualified education, which correspond to the UN Sustainable Development Goals.

I am sincerely looking forward to seeing your interests and active participations in GAIC-MUN, so that students as global leaders can obtain not only skills for negotiations and presentations but also visions for righteous and just society.
