ANN: 이제 시작하겠습니다.

1번 대화를 듣고, 여자가 구입할 쿠션을 고르시오.

M: Hello, ma'am. What can I do for you?

W: Hi, I'd like to buy a cushion.

M: All right. These are the ones we have. There are square- and heart-shaped ones.

W: Oh, I like these heart-shaped ones. I'll get one of them.

M: Okay. And there are two styles, plain and striped.

W: Well, I prefer a striped one.

M: All right. One of them has the word 'LOVE' on it.

W: I prefer the one without it. I'll take this one.
