Intelligence type	Contents	Related jobs	Example figure
Linguistic-verbal	Ability to speak correctly, understand language, and express it in writing	Sports commentator, writer, reporter, Anchor, interpreter	Ex) Kim Young-Ha, Yoo Jae-suk
Interpersonal	Ability to harmonize relationships by understanding minds and emotions of others	Nursery teacher, headhunter, sales, cabin crew	Ex) Lincoln, Churchill
Intrapersonal	Ability to objectively and deeply understand one's own psychology and emotions	Philosopher, psychologist, psychotherapist, religious leader	Ex) Freud, Seongcheol
Naturalistic	Ability to recognize and analyze the environment, such as animals, plants, and surrounding things	Landscape architect, agrotechnician, aquaculturist, atmosphere environment engineer, livestock farmer	Ex) Heo Jun, Fabre, Yun Mu-bu
Visual-spatial	Ability to construct and create shapes, drawings, maps, and solids	Architect, racer, water supply engineer, surveyor, air traffic controller	Ex) Picasso, Gaudi, Walt Disney
Musical-rhythmic and harmonic	Ability to respond and express sensitively to pitch, rhythm, melody, and tone of the sound	Singer, sound engineer, Korean traditional musician, musical instrument player, music therapist	Ex) Mozart, Jeon Somi, BTS
Logical-mathematical	Abilities related to logic, reasoning, problem-solving, analyzing, and mathematical calculations	Energy engineer, tax accountant, robotics engineer, foreign exchange dealer, economics researcher	Ex) Einstein, Bill Gates
Bodily-kinesthetic	Ability to learn and express dance, athletics, acting, etc.	Cheerleader, dancer, sports instructor, bodyguard, firefighter	Ex) Son Heung-min, Han Hyun-min
