

Moon's lead widens

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Public support for liberal presidential contenders remains strong following Acting President and Prime Minister Hwang Kyo-ahn's decision not to run for the presidency, a poll showed Thursday.

Conservative voters seem to be at a loss, as Hwang, who was considered the strongest potential hopeful, is gone and there are no other big name contenders.

Moon Jae-in, former leader of the main opposition Democratic Party of Korea (DPK), extended his lead in the race, gaining a 37.1 percent approval rating in the opinion poll conducted by Realmeter on 1,015 adults right after Hwang dropped his presidential ambitions Wednesday.

His support rate went up from 36 percent recorded right after former President Park Geun-hye was removed from office on March 10. Moon has maintained the top ranking for 11 consecutive weeks.

South Chungcheong Province Governor An Hee-jung, another hopeful from the DPK, ranked second with a 16.8 percent support rating, up by 2.7 percentage points from the previous week.

Coming in third is former leader of the minor opposition People's Party Ahn Cheol-soo who garnered 11.1 percent, up by 1.8 percentage points. Ahn has had a close race with Seongnam Mayor Lee Jae-myung from the DPK, whose ranking fell from third to fourth with an unchanged approval rating of 10.3 percent.

South Gyeongsang Province Governor Hong Joon-pyo's approval rating increased the most, from 3.6 percent to 7.1 percent.
