


What To Do When Concerned About the Ill Effects of Drugs



Addiction is a chronic brain disease



- ✓ Addiction is a **chronic disease** that alters the brain completely. Treatment involves a painful process and often requires a lifetime effort.
- ✓ There are **no exceptions in terms of addiction**. No one can overcome addiction alone.
- ✓ **Early detection and treatment are the first and foremost steps to treat addiction.**

Drug addiction is **not a personal issue**



- ✓ Drug addiction is **not just the drug user's problem**.
- ✓ Drug addiction causes **irreparable harm** not just to the user but to **his or her surroundings**, including family, friends, and colleagues.
- ✓ If one of your children or family members shows **unusual behavior** or **significant mood swings** and is suspected of drug use, **make sure he or she receives appropriate counselling and treatment as soon as possible**.

Report suspicions of drug-related crimes



Call **112** (Police),
1301 (Prosecutors' Office),
or **125** (Korea Customs Service)
for suspected
drug-related crimes.

- ✓ Hiding a drug-related crime out of fear of punishment, especially because your family member or friend is involved, can lead to bigger problems.
- ✓ Drug users are not punished when it is evident that they used the drug without intention and knowledge.

- ✓ Our collective effort can help foster a drug-free, bright, and healthy society.
- ✓ Parents/guardians are advised to pay close attention to their children to prevent them from being exposed to drug use or involved in drug-related crimes.
