<input type="checkbox"/> concern	a feeling of worry about something important, or the thing that worries you <i>e.g. There is growing concern about the safety of mobile phones.</i>
<input type="checkbox"/> concentrate	to think very carefully about something you are doing <i>e.g. With all this noise, I cannot concentrate on studying.</i>
<input type="checkbox"/> reveal	to make something known that was previously secret or not known <i>e.g. Mr. Jackson really did not want to reveal the truth to his son.</i>
<input type="checkbox"/> improve	to become better, or to make something better <i>e.g. How can I improve my self-confidence in everyday life?</i>
<input type="checkbox"/> coincidence	a surprising situation in which two similar events happen by chance at the same time or to the same people <i>e.g. What a coincidence! You and I have the same name!</i>
<input type="checkbox"/> demonstrate	to show someone how to do something by doing it yourself <i>e.g. The man demonstrated how to use the app.</i>
<input type="checkbox"/> adapt	to change your behavior or ideas to fit a new situation <i>e.g. The workers had to adapt quickly to the new system.</i>
<input type="checkbox"/> personality	someone's character, especially the way they behave towards other people <i>e.g. Julie has an outgoing personality, so everyone loves her.</i>
<input type="checkbox"/> adventurous	wanting to do new, exciting, and dangerous things <i>e.g. She was a bold and adventurous explorer.</i>
